Some Important Exam Rules:

- Students should arrive at the college at least 15 minutes before the start of the scheduled examination.
- Bring a valid form of identification, such as a student ID card and admit card.
- Bring only the materials allowed for the exam, such as pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, and any permitted reference materials or calculators
- Using mobile phones and smart watches during exam time is strictly prohibited.

If anyone is found using such devices

 - A fine of Rs.500 will be charged
 - The confiscated device will be returned only after at least a day
- Sit at the designated seat assigned by the invigilator.
- Raise your hand if you need clarification on any question or instruction.
- Permitted to use the washroom after one hour from the start of the exam so raise your hand to get the attention of an invigilator.
- Students taking terminal exams are not permitted to leave the class until an hour has elapsed from the start of the exam.
- If any student is unable to attend the examinations due to personal reasons, they must inform in advance by sending an email to admin.nist@nacol.edu.np & exam@nacolnlist.edu.np. Notifications through calls, SMS, or WhatsApp will not be accepted.
- Students who are absent from an examination without a valid or emergency reason will be required to pay a fine of Rs. **500**, while students who fail the examination will pay a fine of **Rs. 300** to appear in the re-examination.
